



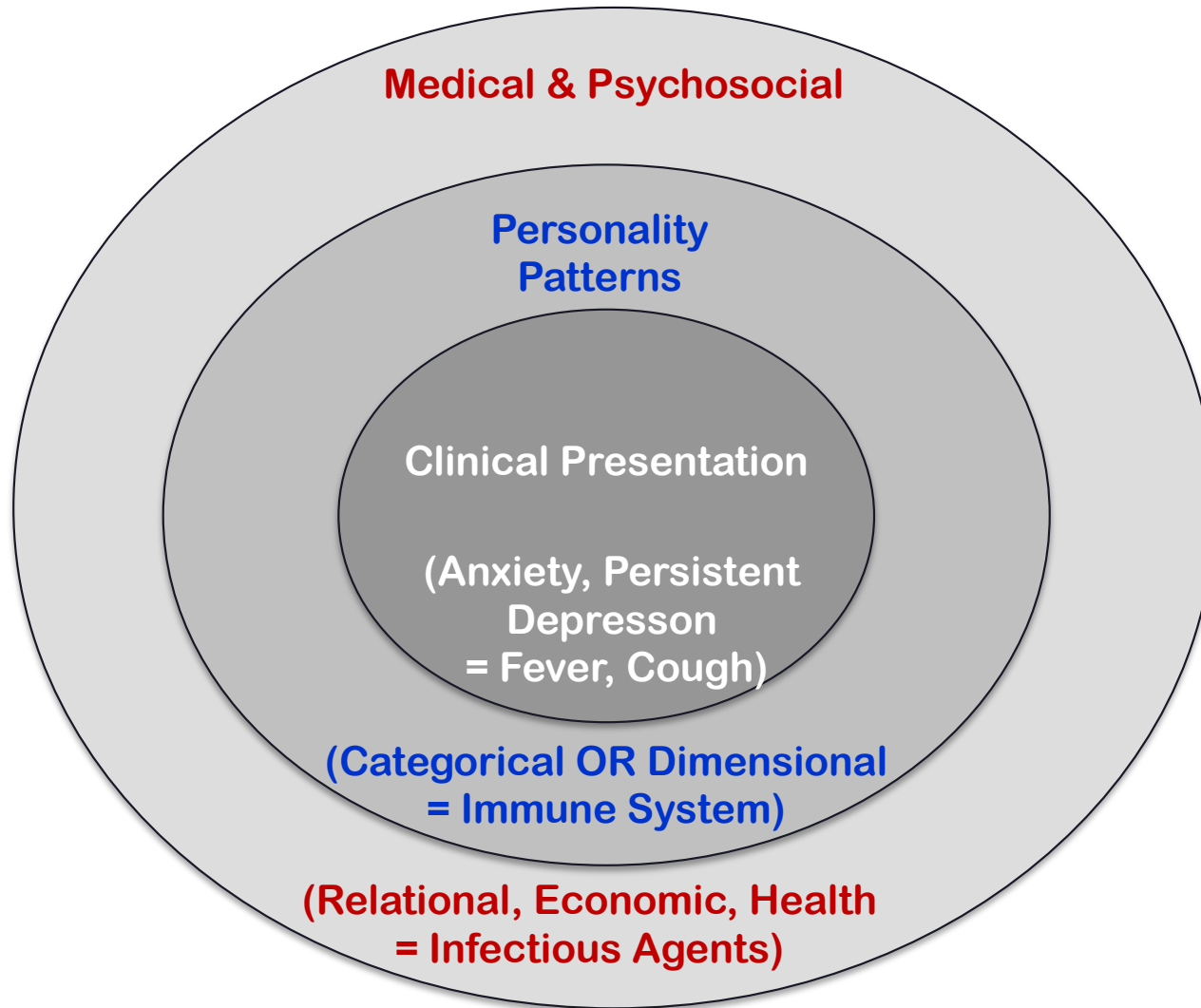

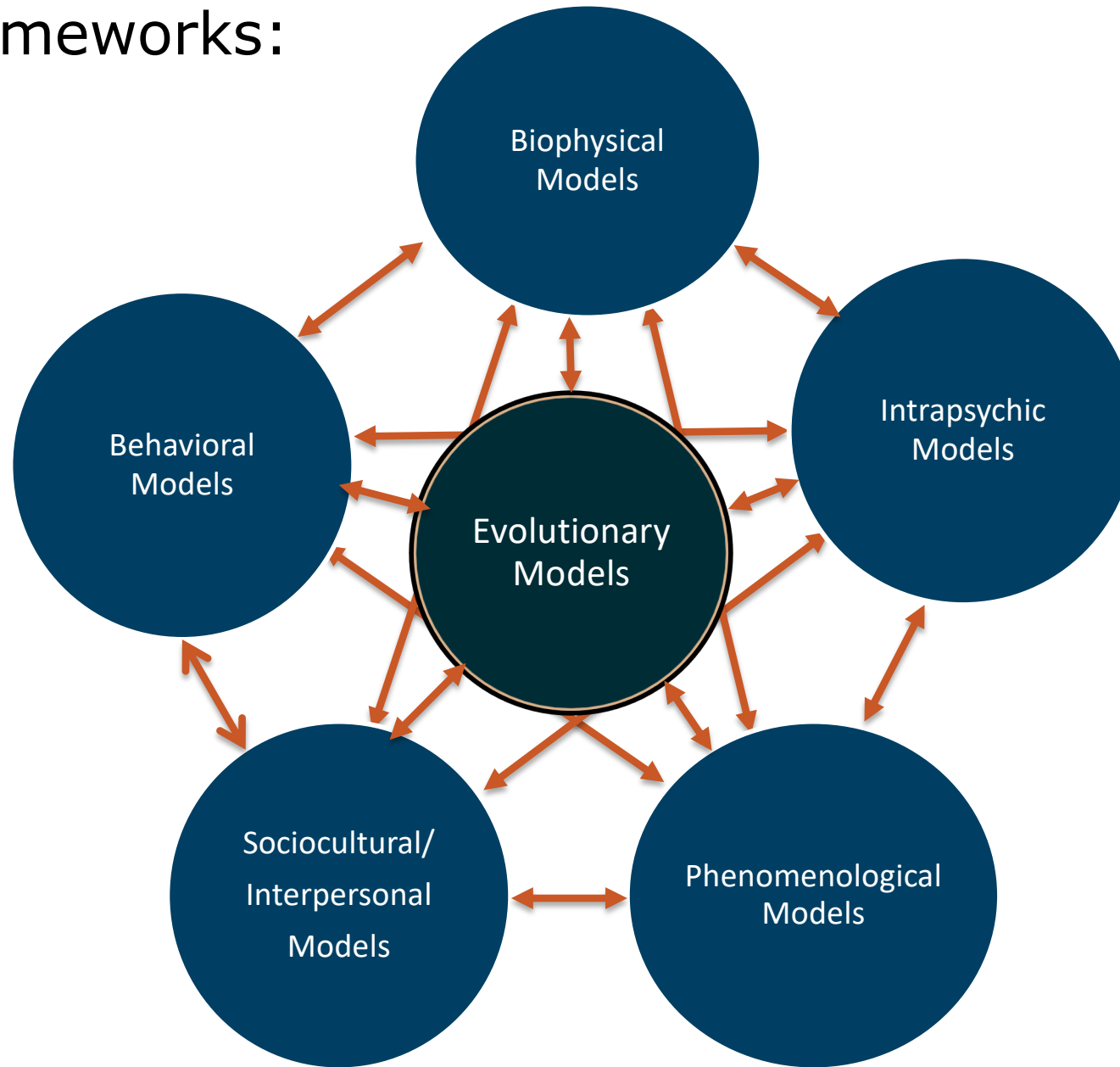

Millon, T. (2011). Disorders of Personality (3rd Ed.)

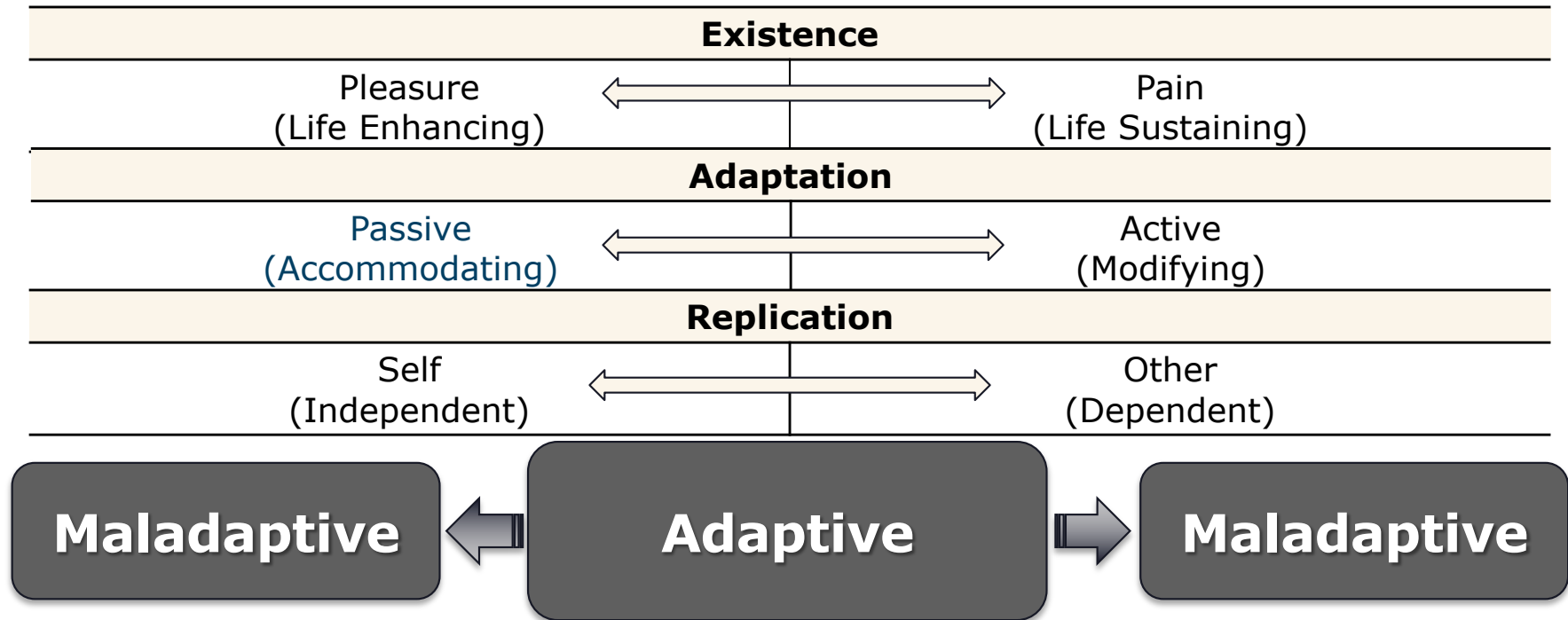


Psychological/Personality Frameworks:



Millon Evolutionary Model

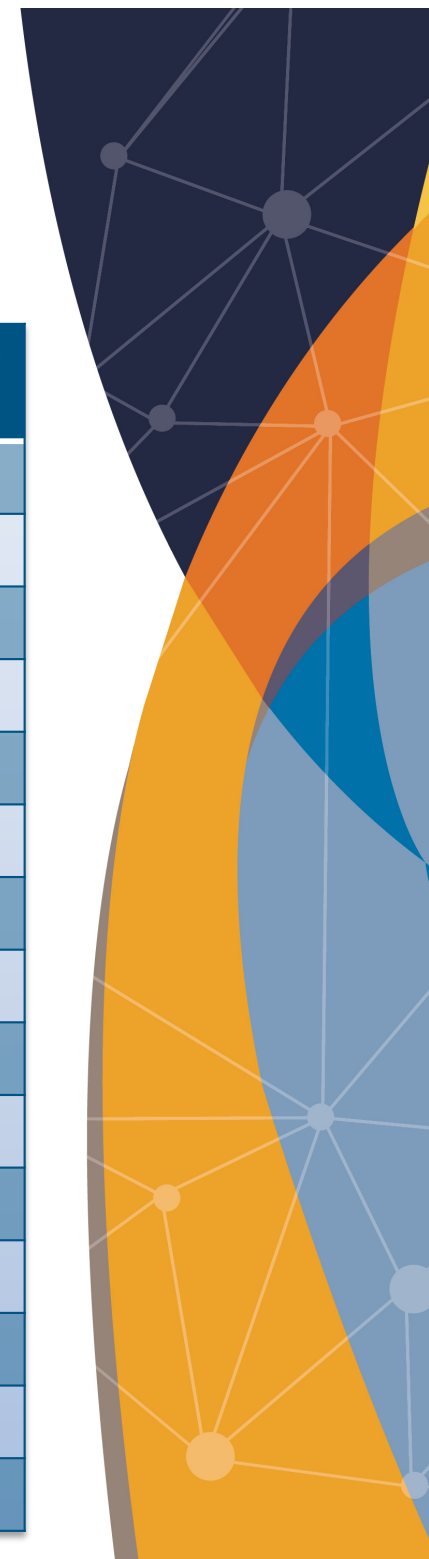

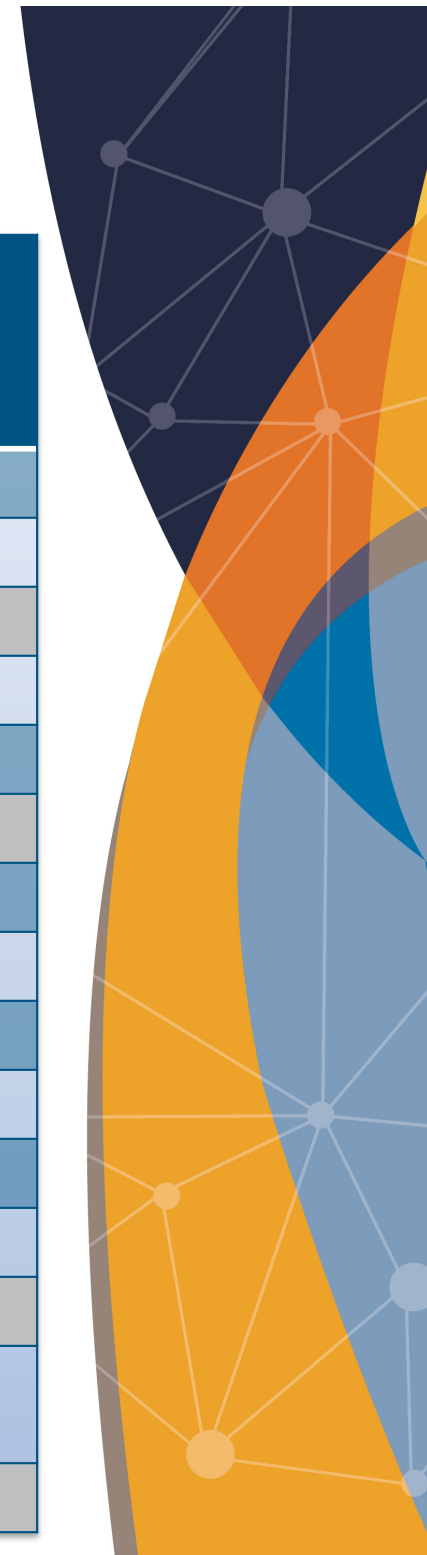
